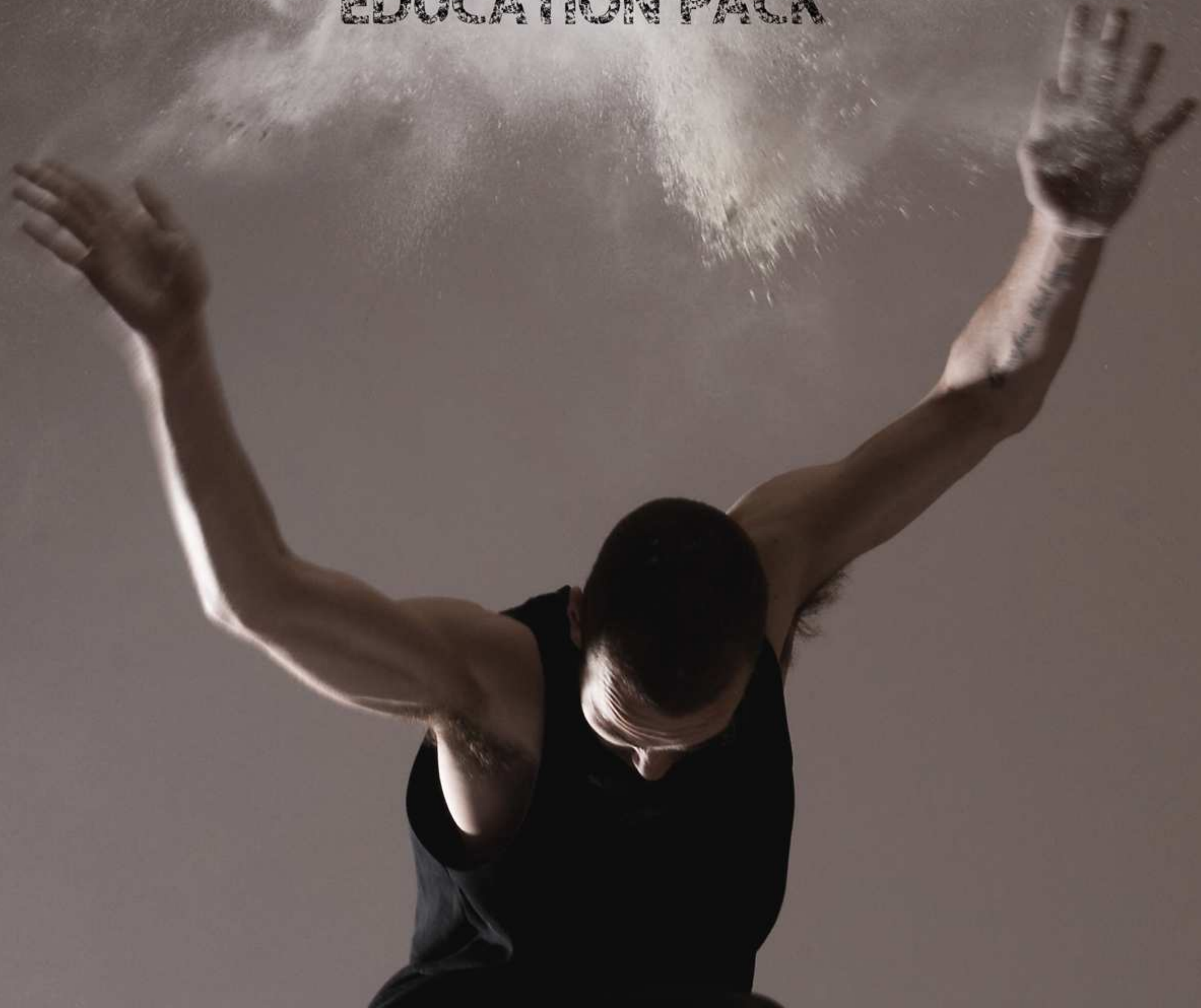

Residencies

2Faced Dance offer workshop residencies, typically three days or longer, in schools, venues and communities across the UK. The workshops include classes and the creation of a performance piece for the final day.

Cluster Classes

These workshops are aimed to bring you and your neighbouring school or club together and experience the 2Faced dance workshop as a community. We offer day workshops and residencies

Curtain Raisers

Want a chance for your group to perform before the performance of In the Dust? 2Faced Dance are offering groups the chance to create a piece in two days then perform it prior to the company's performance in their local area. This is an amazing opportunity to work closely with the team, perform alongside the company and technical team, learn about the work and then see the show at the same time.

INSET Teacher Training Days

The INSET days will equip teachers with creative dance education training. Led by experienced and knowledgeable dance teachers, you'll be trained in how dance can be delivered within the curriculum. Including how to lesson plan, raising performance standards, how to choreograph and create dance for specific age groups all in a comfortable learning department training days or cluster training.

Post Show Talk
