KEY INFORMATION

➡ SHOW LENGTH 30 MINUTES. LAST ORDERS IS AVAILABLE FOR SINGLE DAY (UP TO TWICE A DAY) OR WHOLE FESTIVAL RUNS.

➡ SUITABLE FOR MEDIUM TO LARGE SCALE OUTDOOR SPACES, WITH AUDIENCES BETWEEN 150-500 ON THREE SIDES.

➡ LAST ORDERS CAN BE PRESENTED ON A FLAT, LEVEL SURFACE/HARD STANDING WITH A MINIMUM AREA OF 6M X 6M. THE SHOW CANNOT BE PERFORMED ON GRASS, OR VINYL DANCE FLOOR DUE TO WATER USED IN THE PIECE.

➡ THE SET CONSISTS OF 3 STEEL AND WOOD BAR TABLES, PLASTIC PINT GLASSES AND ONE SMALL BEER KEG (FILLED WITH COLOURED WATER).

➡ THE PIECE INVOLVES SPLASHING OF WATER, SO SOME FESTIVALS MAY PREFER THE AUDIENCE TO BE 2M AWAY FROM THE PERFORMANCE AREA.

➡ AGE GUIDELINE: NONE

➡ TOURING TEAM: 4 PERFORMERS PLUS ONE FESTIVAL SOUND OPERATOR OR 1 2FACED DANCE PRODUCER.

➡ THE BOOKER SHOULD PROVIDE A SUITABLE PA/SOUND SYSTEM CAPABLE OF DEALING WITH FULL RANGE SOUND AND A MINI JACK CONNECTION FOR A SAMSUNG TABLET.

➡ GET IN, GET OUT: A MINIMUM OF ONE HOUR IS REQUIRED FOR THE IN AND 30 MINS FOR THE OUT.

➡ **THE BOOKER SHOULD PROVIDE ACCESS TO A POWER SOURCE AND A 13AMP SOCKET FOR SAMSUNG TABLET USED FOR AUDIO PLAYBACK.**

➡ **DRESSING ROOM: ONE DRESSING ROOM IS REQUIRED WITH A MIRROR AND PREFERABLY HOT AND COLD RUNNING WATER, PLUS A KETTLE AND ACCESS TO WATER.**

➡ **FREE PARKING FOR THE COMPANY TRANSIT VAN IS REQUIRED CLOSE TO THE PERFORMANCE SITE FROM THE GET-IN UNTIL AFTER THE GET-OUT. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE PARKING SPACE MUST HAVE NO HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS.**

➡ **A FULL RISK ASSESSMENT WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY AND AT LEAST 2 WEEKS BEFORE THE EVENT.**

➡ **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EVENT ORGANISER TO OBTAIN ANY NECESSARY LICENCES AND/OR PERMISSIONS.**

➡ **WE ARE COMMITTED TO PROMOTING ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY IN EVERYTHING WE DO. AS SUCH, A GREEN RIDER WILL BE SHARED IN ADVANCE OF THE EVENT.**

Pub Culture

Last Orders offers many potential engagement opportunities. 2Faced Dance are particularly interested in how Last Orders connects with new audiences, young men and themes of men's mental health, identity, and masculinity. 2Faced Dance are keen to discuss ideas with promoters, particularly around where the work can be sited, such as in front of a pub, in a large beer garden or other topical location.

2Faced Dance can also provide a short film, shot and edited by Sam Amos, Last Orders The After Party, to accompany the work.

Serving Sounds by Working Boys Club

Serving Sounds is a multi-sensory sound installation that creates connections through music – a bar that serves bass rather than beer. The installation is an interactive work that can run throughout the daytime and evening. There are spaces for up to four people of all ages to interact with the bar at any one time, each experience lasting up to three minutes – the length of a perfect pop song. There is a capacity for a larger secondary audience, made up of those waiting to take part and others watching and listening. CARL TRAINED AT THE ROYAL WELSH COLLEGE OF MUSIC AND DRAMA AND WAS A FINALIST IN THE PRESTIGIOUS LINBURY BIENNIAL PRIZE FOR STAGE DESIGN.
